ABINGTON STREET MINISTRY—

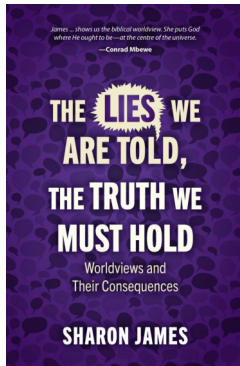
Each Friday 12—2pm. Pray for the speakers and for those who hand out tracts in the crowd, and may be have an opportunity to testify—See Sam for more information.

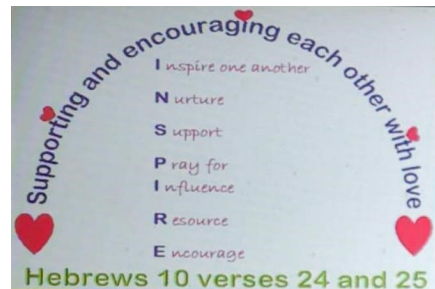
